Iceland: Land of Fire & Ice

Tour Itinerary: Iceland is a unique destination that offers pristine nature including spouting geysers, hot springs and mud pools, wonderful waterfalls, gorgeous coasts and lakes, and breathtaking landscapes—topped off by clean and fresh air! Experience it for yourself as you spend five nights exploring this amazing land of fire and ice.

Day 1, Wed., July 17: Depart Madison. Depart from Madison on your overnight flight to Iceland.

Day 2, Thu., July 18: Reykjavik, Iceland. Upon arrival, you'll be met by your Tour Manager and transferred to your hotel in the town of Hveragerdi. Later, drive northwest to Reykjavik to explore the city. On the included panoramic tour of the world's most northerly capital, see the old town center, Parliament, cathedral, harbor, National Museum, 'Pearl' and Hofoi House, and Hallgrímskirkja Church, where the steeple is a landmark of the city. With power supplied entirely by geothermal water, the city's nickname, "smoking bay" is so named for the rising steam that greeted the city's Viking founder. The center is a collection of charming homes and historic buildings made of stone and timber, contrasting with imaginative modern architecture. This evening, a welcome dinner is included. (D)

Day 3, Fri., July 19: Iceland's South Shore. After breakfast, your adventure to the South Shore begins with a journey through small villages and farmlands to the majestic mountains with views including Mt. Hekla, the most active volcano in Iceland, and the towering, ice-capped strato volcano Eyjafjallajökull, which last erupted in 2010. Iceland is also famous for its waterfalls, and you'll see two of the most magnificent - the Seljalandsfoss, which tumbles over high rock escarpments allowing you to walk behind the waterfall, and Skogafoss. Learn about the preservation of the Southern Iceland

cultural heritage on a visit to the Skogar Folk Museum. Your exploration continues to Dyrholaey, a magnificent rocky headland with sheer cliffs, en route to the village of Vik. Head to the seashore, flanked by steep bird cliffs rising high above the beautiful black sand beach. In the sea just outside of Vik, see the Reynisdrangar Rocks, which stand 216 feet above sea level at their highest point. (B)

Day 4, Sat. July 20: Reykjanes Peninsula and the Blue Lagoon. This morning, head west for the rough tracks of Reykjanes, one of the most active volcanic areas in Iceland. Visit the geothermal area of Krysuvik and Lake Kleifarvtn with its hot springs and solfatares. A remarkable life-enriching experience is a visit to the Blue Lagoon, a lake of warm, mineral-rich geothermal water, internationally renowned for its healing prowess. Located in the middle of a lava field in the pure and beautiful Icelandic wilderness, water is heated by underground volcanic activity at a depth of 5,400 feet and is pumped to the surface to form this man-made wonder. The Blue Lagoon is known for its special properties and its beneficial effect on the skin. You'll have an opportunity to soak in the pleasantly warm water, catch a healthy drink at the swim-up bar. (B)

Day 5, Sun., July 21: Reykjavik-Whale Watching. Depart the hotel and travel to Reykjavik for an included whale-watching excursion. The naturalist guides onboard the vessel will share their knowledge of these magnificent creatures while searching for pods of whales in the area. Enjoy some free time in the city center before returning to the hotel. (B)

Day 6, Mon., July 22: The Golden Circle. On a full-day tour of the Golden Circle combines scenic drives with geological and historic sites. Your excursion includes a drive to the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Thingvellir National Park, a remarkable geological site that is one of the few spots in the world where the Mid-Atlantic Ridge is seen above water. The amazing canyon that runs through the park is a meeting point of two of the earth's tectonic plates. The park is situated by Lake Thingvallavatn, the largest lake on the island. The park is also the most historic site on the island as the world's oldest democratic parliament was

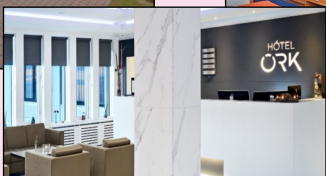
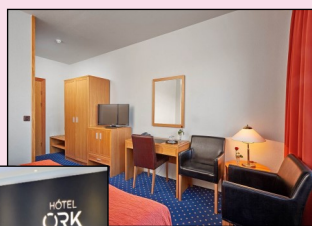
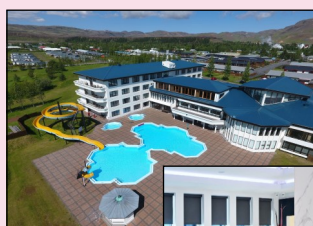
founded here in 930 AD. You'll see outstanding natural wonders when you visit Geysir, known for its thermal activity. View 'Strokkur,' one of the most active geysers, and 'Gullfoss' (Golden Waterfall), Iceland's most famous waterfall. Before returning to the hotel, a visit to a local farm gives you the chance to meet some of the native Icelandic horses, as well as learn about the growing of healthy tomatoes using green energy, pure water and organic pest controls. This evening, join your travel companions for a farewell dinner. (B)(D)

TOUR TERMS AND CONDITIONS - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

I.D./Citizenship: Travelers must possess a passport that is valid for at least six months beyond the return date of the tour, with name matching the name on tour documents. Complete passport name, gender and birth date are required to confirm reservations per TSA/airline requirements. Non-US passport holders are responsible for determining their own entry requirements.

Deposits and Payments: Please make checks payable to Burkhalter Tours. Most major credit cards are also accepted, although a cash discount is sometimes offered. A deposit of **\$300 per person (+ Mayflower insurance premium if you choose to buy that)** is required to secure reservations. Final payment is due by or before **April 6, 2019**. All tour confirmations are subject to receipt of signed tour application and payment verification.

Cancellations/Refunds: All cancellations are subject to a \$50 Burkhalter Tours service fee that may not be covered by tour operator insurance. In addition to the service fee and possible airline penalties, tour cancellation penalties are as follows: 151+ days prior to departure: Service Fee. 150-91 days prior: Deposit; 90-45 days prior: 20%; 44-15 days prior: 30%; 14-1 days prior: 50%; departure day and later: 100% non-refundable. No refund will apply on unused portions of the tour. If a roommate cancels, the remaining traveler may have to pay any single room supplement that is incurred. Name changes and departure date changes are considered reservation cancellations and are subject to cancellation fees. Once issued, airline tickets are 100% non-refundable.

Travel Insurance is strongly advised in order to protect your investment. Coverage for trip cancellation/interruption/delay, and medical emergency expenses is available from Mayflower for \$199. Other plans may also be available. Ask your agent for information.

Tour Conditions: This tour is a regular Mayflower Tours departure and no minimum number of Burkhalter travelers is required for the tour to operate. With 20 paid travelers, A Burkhalter Tours host may accompany the group to provide additional service throughout the tour. All arrangements are based upon tariffs in effect on date of brochure production and are subject to change. Once deposit has been received, any changes to air or land arrangements may be assessed a \$50 revision fee. Revision fees may be higher once air is ticketed. Itinerary is subject to change by the tour operator.

Air Transportation: The airfare portion of the tour price is subject to change until ticketed. Group seat assignments are done by the airlines on behalf of everyone in the group. Specific seat assignments can only be requested after final payment and may be limited in availability. If specific seat assignments are vital to your enjoyment of the tour, we recommend individual air reservations. Deviations from the group air schedule may result in a different airfare. Traveler Fitness: Travelers should be in reasonably good health, able to climb stairs and board a motorcoach in a timely manner, and walk moderate distances, sometimes over uneven ground.
