Start with a morning visit and docent led tour of the Larurent House! Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, the Laurent House is the only building that world-renowned architect Frank Lloyd Wright designed for a disabled client. Designed in 1949, using his



Usonian hemicycle style of intersecting arcs, this organic architecture drew on Wright's life-time interest in Japanese art and architecture that married natural materials, such as the House's Chicago common brick and Tidewater red cypress, with the indoor and outdoor environments.

Later, travel to the Rockford's Anderson Japanese Gardens, where you will have lunch. Afterwards, embark on a private tour of the gardens, a twelve-acre landscape of streams, waterfalls, winding paths ad koi-filled ponds. Its renowned designer, Hochic Kruisu, has carefully planned the placement of every rock, the alignment of every tree and the layout of every pathway. Enjoy time on your own to explore the gardens and gift shop before departing at 3:30 p.m.
