

**Tour Itinerary:** New Orleans, Tupelo, Memphis, Nashville. Whether you are a fan of country, blues, rock 'n' roll or soul music, you are sure to enjoy these iconic destinations for every music lover!

Day 1, Sun., Nov. 1: Depart Home. Fly from Madison Airport to New Orleans, Louisiana. Your Tour Director will be available this afternoon to answer any questions or point you in the right direction.

Day 2, Mon., Nov. 2: New Orleans. The morning is dedicated to the sights and sounds of this Old World city on a guided sightseeing tour. First, visit the French Quarter, including St. Louis Cathedral and Jackson Square. Next, learn about the city's unique burial customs at an above-ground cemetery, followed by a leisurely drive down historic St. Charles Avenue to enjoy its stately mansions and clanging streetcars.

Day 3, Tue., Nov. 3: New Orleans—Tupelo—Memphis. Visit Elvis' Birthplace and Museum in Tupelo, a small, 2-room house built by the singer's father, Vernon Presley. For music lovers, a visit to the Stax Museum of American

Soul Music is next. Then, on to the Rock 'n' Soul Museum, which traces Memphis' cultural and musical past. End the day with a visit to Sun Studio, probably the most famous recording studio in the world, where rock 'n' roll was first recorded. Hear outtakes from sessions, touch Elvis' first microphone, see

memorabilia, and relive the history of the studio that launched the careers of Johnny Cash, BB King and many other music legends.

Day 5, Thu., Nov. 5: Memphis—Graceland Excursion. Today is dedicated to a guided audio tour of Graceland. Experience life as Elvis did by walking through the decadent and quirky rooms where he felt truly at home. Finish your tour of Graceland with a visit to the Meditation Garden, where Elvis often went to reflect on life, and where he is now laid to rest along with members of his family. You'll also be able to board "The King's" private jet! Tonight check in to the Guest House at Graceland.

Day 6, Fri., Nov. 6: Memphis—Nashville. A tour of iconic music cities would not be complete without Nashville—"Music City USA." Upon arrival, go behind the scenes of the music industry by visiting the Country Music Hall of Fame with its glittering costumes, rare instruments, and Elvis Presley's "solid-gold" Cadillac. This evening, join the optional outing and be entertained with songs from so many of country music's greats by the next big country music star!



Day 7, Sat., Nov. 7: Nashville. Nashville is the ideal destination for music fans,

history buffs, and lovers of the South. Start your day with a visit to RCA Studio B, Nashville's oldest surviving recording studio and one of the country's most important. Between 1957 and 1977, more than 35,000 songs were recorded here, including 262 Elvis Presley recordings. Studio B is a "must-see" for any music fan, but especially for those who love Elvis. Afterward, enjoy an orientation tour of the city, passing by famous Music Row recording studios, the center of the recording industry, which first developed in the 1950s. Tonight, see an unforgettable show at the world-famous Grand Ole Opry, the world's premier country music venue since 1925 and the setting for the nation's longest-running music show. (B)

## **TOUR TERMS AND CONDITIONS - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY**

*I.D./Citizenship*: Names must match the traveler's photo I.D. Complete I.D. name, gender and birth date are required to confirm reservations per TSA/airline requirements.

**Deposits and Payments:** Please make checks payable to Burkhalter Tours. Most major credit cards are also accepted. A deposit of **\$300 per person** is required to secure reservations. All tour confirmations are subject to receipt of signed tour application and payment verification. **Final payment is due by July 31, 2020.** 

**Cancellations/Refunds:** All cancellations are subject to a \$50 Burkhalter Tours service fee that may not be covered by tour operator insurance. In addition to the service fee and possible airline penalties, tour cancellation penalties are as follows:

Cancel prior to July 31, 2020: Deposit is non-refundable

Cancel after July 31, 2020: Trip is non-refundable

No refund will apply on unused portions of the tour. If a roommate cancels, the remaining traveler may have to pay any single room supplement that is incurred. Name changes and departure date changes are considered reservation cancellations and are subject to cancellation fees. Once issued, airline tickets are 100% non-refundable.

**Travel Insurance** is strongly advised in order to protect your investment. Coverage for trip cancellation/interruption/delay, and medical emergency expenses is available from the tour supplier, Cosmos for \$199. Other plans may also be available. Ask your agent for information.

**Tour Conditions**: This tour is a regular Cosmos departure and no minimum number of Burkhalter travelers is required for the tour to operate. All arrangements are based upon tariffs in effect on date of brochure production and are subject to change.
