Later board your motorcoach and travel to the resort city of Mesquite, Nevada located northeast of Las Vegas on the edge of the Nevada/Arizona border featuring entertainment, golf and gaming. Mesquite's rugged desert setting is a great home base to explore the Southwest's most popular National Parks. Check into your resort hotel for a three night stay. (B, L)

Day 4, Wed.., October 21: Bryce Canyon National Park. Today enjoy the beautiful scenery as you travel into southwestern Utah for a full day visit at one of our country's most popular National Parks, Bryce Canyon National Park, a horseshoe bowl of fanciful formations. The various shades of red, rose and pink blend magnificently with many tones of white creating breathtaking sights. Enter the park in Springdale and experience a Zion Park Tram Tour to view the spectacular combination of multicolored canyons, sheer cliffs, streams, waterfalls and foliage that are all part of this beautiful park's backdrop. Later visit the historic Zion Lodge, the hub of this wonderful National Park. After your Zion experience, enjoy a Farewell Dinner at a local restaurant in the Zion Park area. After dinner return to Mesquite. (B, D)

Day 6, Fri.., October 23: Mesquite, NV - Valley of Fire - Las Vegas. This morning visit Valley of Fire State Park, Nevada's oldest and largest state park, which derives its name from red sandstone formations formed from sand dunes during the age of dinosaurs. Ancient trees and early man are represented throughout the park by areas of petrified wood and 3,000 year-old Native American petroglyphs. Transfer to the Las Vegas Airport filled with wonderful memories of your National Parks and Canyons of the Southwest Tour. (B)

## **TOUR TERMS AND CONDITIONS - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY**

**I.D./Citizenship:** Travelers must possess a passport valid for at least six months beyond the tour dates with names matching those on their tour and flight reservations. A visa will also be required at added expense. Complete name, gender and birth date are required to confirm reservations per TSA/airline requirements.

**Deposits and Payments:** Please make checks payable to Burkhalter Tours. Most major credit cards are also accepted, although a cash count may be offered. A **deposit of \$350 per person plus insurance** if you choose to buy is required to secure reservations. All tour confirmations are subject to receipt of signed tour application and payment verification. **Final payment is due by July 21, 2020.** 

**Cancellations/Refunds:** All cancellations are subject to a \$50 Burkhalter Tours service fee that may not be covered by tour operator surance. In addition to the service fee and possible airline penalties, tour cancellation penalties are as follows:

Cancel prior to July 21, 2020: Deposit is non-refundable

Cancel after July 21, 2020: Trip is non-refundable

No refund will apply on unused portions of the tour. If a roommate cancels, the remaining traveler may have to pay any single room supplement that is incurred. Name changes and departure date changes are considered reservation cancellations and are subject to cancellation fees. Once issued, airline tickets are 100% non-refundable.

**Travel Insurance** is strongly advised in order to protect your investment. Coverage for trip cancellation/interruption/delay, and medical emergency expenses is available from **Premier Travel Protection for \$275.** Other plans may also be available. Ask your agent for info.

**Tour Conditions**: This tour is a regular Premier World Discovery departure and no minimum number of Burkhalter travelers is required for the tour to operate. With 20 paid travelers, A Burkhalter Tours host may accompany the group to provide additional service throughout the tour. All arrangements are based upon tariffs in effect June 2, 2020 and are subject to change. Once deposit has been received, any changes to air or land arrangements may be assessed a \$50 revision fee. Revision fees may be higher once air is ticketed. Itinerary is subject to change by the tour operator.

Air Transportation: The airfare portion of the tour pricing is subject to change until ticketed. Airline schedules are subject to change by the airlines at any time.
