

Tour Itinerary: This leisurely-paced journey into Alaska's heartland combines a seven-day land tour and a seven-day cruise with sightseeing in Fairbanks, Denali National Park, Anchorage, Seward, Glacier Bay, Haines/Skagway, Juneau, Ketchikan and Vancouver.

Day 1, Sun., June 13: *Depart for Fairbanks, Alaska.* Fly from Chicago's O'Hare Airport to Fairbanks, Alaska. Transfer to your downtown hotel.

Day 2, Mon., June 14: Fairbanks. This morning seek out riches as you pan for gold at Gold Dredge #8. After a hearty lunch, take a step back in time on board the Sternwheeler Riverboat Discovery. Your three-hour cruise will introduce you to the rivers of Alaska featuring a floatplane takeoff, a stop at the home of four-time Iditarod champion Susan Butcher, and immersion into Athabascan culture at the Chena Indian Village.

Day 3, Tue., June 15: *Fairbanks - Denali.* It's off to Denali National Park by luxury motorcoach. There will be free time to explore the park or take an optional excursion this afternoon and evening. You are sure to enjoy your two-night stay at this magnificent national treasure.

Day 4, Wed., June 16: Denali. Wake up early this morning for a Tundra Wilderness tour (6-8 hours) deep into the park to look for wildlife...caribou, Dall sheep, moose, grizzly bear or wolves. Weather permitting, visit the best lookouts for Mt. Denali. The afternoon offers time to relax, take a hike with a National Park guide, or sign up for optional activities like flightseeing, river rafting or the Music of Denali dinner show. (Snack)

Day 5, Thu., June 17: *Denali - Anchorage.* This morning, board the luxurious domed rail cars of the McKinley Explorer bound for Anchorage. Eat lunch on board and arrive in the late afternoon to explore the city sights at your leisure. (L)

Day 6, Fri., June 18: *Anchorage - Alyeska.* Begin your journey to the sea along the Turnagain Arm stopping for a Portage Glacier Cruise on the way to Alyeska Resort - your 5-star base camp for optional excursions, fine dining, and luxurious spa





services. Nearby Prince William Sound offers wilderness options. You may choose an optional excursion to hop aboard a high-speed catamaran and travel 140 miles to see 26 "named" glaciers, as well as an abundance of wildlife—both on shore and through the narrow fjords. Choose one of many local restaurants for a special evening meal.

Day 7, Sat., June 19: Alyeska - Whittier. Continue by motorcoach along scenic Turnagain Arm enjoying a stop at the Alaska Wildlife Conservation Center on your way to Seward. Enjoy time on your own upon arrival.

Day 8, Sun., June 20: Depart Whittier - Check-In At 1:00p. There's time today to take an optional excursion into spectacular Kenai Fjords National Park before you board your ship, Holland America's ms Noordam. (D)

Day 9, Mon., June 21: Scenic Cruising. At sea today on the Gulf of Alaska, enjoy a leisurely day of cruising. There's plenty of activities on board including Alaska-themed lectures, shows, gambling, art auctions, spa treatments and much more! (B,L,D)

Or, head to Skagway for a ride on the White Pass and Yukon Route Railroad. (B,L,D)

Day 12, Thu., June 24: Juneau - 8:00a-6:00p. Set against a majestic backdrop of towering mountains with immense ice-fields at its back door, Juneau, the state capital, has a gold rush story to rival the Klondike. Excursions are available including excellent whale watching opportunities, a gondola ride up Mt. Roberts, city sightseeing and more. The new Alaska State Museum offers everything from native peoples culture to oil industry insights to World War II history. (B,L,D)

Day 13, Fri., June 25: Ketchikan - 11:00a-7:00p. Ketchikan has long been an important hub of the salmon-fishing and packing industries - try your luck on a sport-fishing excursion or simply savor the fresh seafood at one of the local restaurants. It is also one of the best spots along the Inside Passage to explore the rich cultural sights of Native Alaskan nations like the Tlingit, Haida and Tsimshian. You can see intricately carved totem poles at the Totem Heritage Center and Totem Bight State Park, while the attractions of Saxman Village just outside of Ketchikan offers the chance to see Tlingit culture in action, with working carvers and a dance show in the clan house. Day 14, Sat., June 26: Scenic Cruising - The Inside Passage. Relax and enjoy a full day of scenic Inside Passage cruising and immerse yourself in Holland America Line elegance. Take the polar bear plunge, spend time in the spa, take a computer class or enjoy a cooking demonstration. There are so many things to do! (B,L,D)

Day 15, Sun., June 27: Vancouver and Return Trip Home. After disembarking, board your flight back to Chicago.

Terms and Conditions

I.D./Citizenship: Travelers must possess a passport book (not card) that is valid for at least six months beyond the tour's conclusion with names matching those on their tour and flight reservations. Complete name, gender and birth date are required to confirm reservations per TSA/airline requirements. It is recommended that any person charged with, or convicted of, a crime (including DUI) obtain the necessary approval before attempting to enter Canada.

Deposits and Payments: Please make checks payable to Burkhalter Tours. Most major credit cards are also accepted, although sometimes a cash discount may be offered. A deposit of \$600 per person is required to secure reservations. All tour confirmations are subject to receipt of signed tour application and payment verification. **Final payment is due by March 5, 2021.**

Cancellations/Refunds: All cancellations are subject to a \$50 Burkhalter Tours service fee that may not be covered by tour operator insurance. In addition to the service fee and possible airline penalties, tour cancellation penalties are as follows:

Cancel prior to March 5, 2021: Deposit is non-refundable Cancel after March 5, 2021: Trip is non-refundable

If a roommate cancels, the remaining traveler may have to pay any single room supplement that is incurred. Name changes and departure date changes are considered reservation cancellations and are subject to cancellation fees. Once issued, airline tickets are 100% non-refundable.

Tour Conditions: This tour is a regular Holland America tour departure and no minimum number of Burkhalter travelers is required for the tour to operate. With 20 Burkhalter participants, a Burkhalter Tours host may travel with the group to provide leadership on flights and while traveling. All arrangements are based upon tariffs in effect on May 4, 2020 and are subject to change. Once deposit has been received, any changes to air or land arrangements may be assessed a \$50 revision fee. Revision fees may be higher once air is ticketed.

Air Transportation: The airfare portion of the tour price is an estimate and is based on a group air contract requiring a minimum of 10 travelers. Airline seat assignments can only be requested after final payment and may be limited in availability. If specific seat assignments are vital to your enjoyment of the tour, we recommend individual air reservations. Deviations from the group air schedule may result in a different airfare. Routing and schedules are subject to change.

Accommodations/Coach Transportation: Tour hotels are considered the best available and include private ensuite facilities, typically with two beds. Touring coaches are deluxe vehicles with panoramic windows and seats that partially recline. Single travelers are allocated one seat only.

Traveler Fitness: Travelers should be in reasonably good health, able to climb stairs and walk moderate distances. Individuals with physical and/or cognitive limitations must be accompanied by an able individual who will assume complete responsibility for them - tour personnel cannot and will not provide such assistance.

Passenger Consent Agreement: Department of Transportation regulations require that we inform you that your purchase is subject to supplemental price increases beyond our control that may be imposed after the date of purchase. Such increases may come about due to increased fees, fuel surcharges, government tax increases, fluctuations in foreign exchange markets or any combination of these events. Post-purchase price increases may be applied to your invoice due to these unforeseen cost increases from suppliers.
