And with a small group - of no more than 6 guests per vehicle and 20 guests total - you'll experience a high level of service throughout your adventure! Magnificent wildlife, important animal sanctuaries and thrilling adventures—this exciting safari in Kenya and Tanzania has it all. It's a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity not to be missed.

Day 1, Fri., Sep. 11: Depart Home. Fly overnight from Chicago's O'Hare Airport to Nairobi, Kenya.

Day 2, Sat., Sep. 12: Arrive in Nairobi, Kenya. Welcome to Africa! Arrive this evening, check in to your hotel, and prepare for your safari adventure!

Day 3, Sun., Sep. 13: Nairobi—Mount Kenya—Samburu National Reserve. Depart Nairobi to begin your search for the "Big 5"—lion, leopard, elephant, rhino and Cape buffalo. Stop at the famed Mount Kenya Safari Club for lunch as you take in stunning views of Mount Kenya. Continue on to Samburu National Reserve, known for its arid landscape and unique wildlife. Due to the dry climate, grasses are sparse, making animals easier to spot. Meanwhile, the Ewaso Ng'iro River,



which borders the reserve, provides a year-round water supply. These two factors make for a great game-viewing experience. You will have the chance to see rare animals you will not see in other parts of the country. Commonly referred to as the Samburu "Special 5," this includes Grevy's zebra, reticulated giraffe, Somali ostrich, beisa oryx, and the gerenuk, a long-necked antelope that feeds while standing on its hind feet. (B,L,D)

Day 4, Mon., Sep. 14: Samburu. Today, enjoy morning & afternoon game drives. In addition to the Samburu "Special 5," the reserve is home to an abundance of other species. Large numbers of elephant and Nile crocodile



can be seen, as well as waterbuck, Kirk's dik-dik and Grant's gazelle. Where there is prey, predators can be found, so lion and leopard are often spotted. The reserve is also a great place for bird watching, with over 300 species. Between game drives, there's time to relax at your lodge. (B,L,D)

Day 5, Tue., Sep. 15: Samburu—Ol Pejeta Conservancy. This morning you travel to Ol Pejeta Conservancy, the largest black rhino sanctuary in all of East Africa. Enjoy a game drive in the conservancy, including a stop at the Chimp Sanctuary. In partnership with the Kenya Wildlife Service and the Jane Goodall Institute, the sanctuary was established to provide a long-term home for orphaned and abused chimpanzees. Here, see the chimps and learn more about their plight. (B,L,D)

Day 6, Wed., Sep. 16: Ol Pejeta—Nyahururu Falls—Lake Nakuru National Park. Leave Ol Pejeta and journey through the beautiful Kenyan highlands, one of the most fertile agricultural areas in all of Africa, where farmers grow crops such as corn, wheat, coffee, and tea. Stop at Nyahururu Falls, also known as Thompson's Falls, and then on to Lake Nakuru National Park. During your afternoon game drive you may see waterbuck, giraffe, impala, flamingo and striped hyena. This is also your best chance to see white rhino, which are commonly spotted here. (B,L,D)



Day 7, Thu., Sep. 17: Lake Nakuru—Maasai Mara National Reserve. This morning, depart for Maasai Mara National Reserve, Kenya's most famous game area. "The Mara" is part of the Serengeti ecosystem and boasts a strong permanent population of game. When the Great Migration, generally from August to early November, the population enlarges by almost 2 million. This provides a great food source for predators such as lion, cheetah, leopard, and hyena. (B,L,D)

Day 8, Fri., Sep. 18: Maasai Mara. Rise early for a morning game drive and watch for elephant, rhino, giraffe, topi, hyena and much more. Afterward, a special bush breakfast has been arranged for you. Sip on a mimosa as you savor every moment of the memorable experience! Return to your camp and relax prior to your afternoon game drive. (B,L,D)




Day 9, Sat., Sep. 19: Maasai Mara—Nairobi—Amboseli National Park. After breakfast, board a plane for the quick flight to Nairobi. After a short break, drive to Amboseli National Park, best known for spectacular views of Mount Kilimanjaro, the highest mountain in Africa at some 19,341 feet. Embark on an afternoon game drive before settling in at your lodge. (B,L,D)

Day 10, Sun., Sep. 20: Amboseli. Today you will enjoy both morning and afternoon game drives. Amboseli affords you a great opportunity to get close to the mighty elephant. As the sun sets with "Kili" as the backdrop, savor sundowner drinks in the busy! **(**B,L,D)

Day 11, Mon., Sep. 21: Amboseli—Arusha, Tanzania—Lake Manyara National Park. This morning, cross the border into Tanzania and have a lunch stop in Arusha. Check in to your lodge along the rim of the Great Rift Valley escarpment and enjoy some leisure time prior to dinner. (B,L,D)

Day 12, Tue., Sep. 22: Lake Manyara National Park—Ngorongoro Crater. Embark on a morning game drive in Lake Manyara National Park. This small park is ecologically diverse, with groundwater forests, grassy plains and alkaline Lake Manyara. Watch for elephant, Cape buffalo, giraffe, and more. The park is also



home to the world's largest concentration of baboons. Afterward, take in spectacular views of Lake Manyara during a special Bush lunch. Journey to the nearby village of Tloma where you will visit a local family's home to learn more about the local Iraqw culture and their traditional way of life. You will also stop at a local primary school to visit with the children and learn about the educational system in rural Tanzania. Continue on to the Ngorongoro Conservation Area for 2 nights. (B,L,D)

Day 13, Wed., Sep. 23: Ngorongoro. Enjoy a full day game drive in Ngorongoro Crater, the world's largest unflooded one. This is your best change to see rare black rhinoceros. (B,L,D)

Day 14, Thu., Sep. 24: Ngorongoro—Serengeti National Park. Today, drive to Serengeti National Park, Tanzania's largest and most famous park with great game viewing year round. (B,L,D)

Day 15, Fri., Sep. 25: Serengeti. The Serengeti covers an area of roughly 5,700 square miles, so it is no surprise that the name comes from the Maasai word siringit, meaning "endless plains." Enjoy morning and afternoon game drives, having the change to see the big cats (lion, leopard and cheetah) as well as the Nile crocodile, giraffe, gazelle and elend. Tonight enjoy a farewell Bush Dinner and Traditional Maasai Dance Performance—the perfect end to your safari!



Day 16, Sat., Sep. 26: Serengeti—Arusha—Departure. Fly back to Arusha where your tour ends. You will have a day room available before your overnight homebound flight.

Day 17, Sun., Sep. 27: Arrive Home. Your overnight flight arrives home today.



Terms and Conditions

I.D./Citizenship: Travelers must possess a passport book (not card) that is valid for at least six months beyond the tour's conclusion with names matching those on their tour and flight reservations. Complete name, gender and birth date are required to confirm reservations per TSA/airline requirements. Visa required for U.S. citizens to enter Kenya and Tanzania. It is the customer's responsibility, however, assistance will be provided as needed.

Deposits and Payments: Please make checks payable to Burkhalter Tours. Most major credit cards are also accepted, although sometimes a cash discount may be offered. A deposit of \$550 per person is required to secure reservations. All tour confirmations are subject to receipt of signed tour application and payment verification. **Final payment is due by June 11, 2020.**

Cancellations/Refunds: All cancellations are subject to a \$50 Burkhalter Tours service fee that may not be covered by tour operator insurance. In addition to the service fee and possible airline penalties, tour cancellation penalties are as follows:

Cancel prior to June 11, 2020: Deposit is non-refundable

Cancel after June 11, 2020: Trip is non-refundable

No refund will apply on unused portions of the tour. If a roommate cancels, the remaining traveler may have to pay any single room supplement that is incurred. Name changes and departure date changes are considered reservation cancellations and are subject to cancellation fees. Once issued, airline tickets are 100% non-refundable.

Travel insurance is strongly advised in order to protect your investment. Coverage for trip cancellation/interruption/delay, and medical emergency expenses is available from Globus for \$299, and we recommend purchase at the time of booking. Ask your agent for more information.

Tour Conditions: This tour is a regular Globus tour departure and no minimum number of Burkhalter travelers is required for the tour to operate. With 20 Burkhalter participants, a Burkhalter Tours host may travel with the group to provide leadership on flights and while traveling. All arrangements are based upon tariffs in effect on June 8, 2020 and are subject to change. Once deposit has been received, any changes to air or land arrangements may be assessed a \$50 revision fee. Revision fees may be higher once air is ticketed. Due to limited capacity on safari vehicles and flights, your suitcase must be soft-sided and cannot exceed 33 lbs, including hand luggage.

Air Transportation: The airfare portion of the tour price is an estimate and is based on a group air contract requiring a minimum of 10 travelers. Airline seat assignments can only be requested after final payment and may be limited in availability. If specific seat assignments are vital to your enjoyment of the tour, we recommend individual air reservations. Deviations from the group air schedule may result in a different airfare. Routing and schedules are subject to change.

Accommodations/Transportation: Tour hotels are considered first class or moderate first class safari lodges and include private ensuite facilities, typically with two beds. Four-wheel drive safari vehicle, between destinations and for game drives, with a popup roof for easy game viewing and photography. We limit each vehicle to a maximum of six people, ensuring you'll always have a window seat.

Traveler Fitness: Travelers should be in reasonably good health, able to climb stairs and walk moderate distances. Individuals with physical and/or cognitive limitations must be accompanied by an able individual who will assume complete responsibility for them - tour personnel cannot and will not provide such assistance. Consult your physician for the latest health requirements for travel to Kenya. All game viewing is done at your own risk. We will require a signed liability waiver prior to travel. We do not recommend this vacation to people with serious back problems, as it can be quite rough driving on/off road in/between game parks.

Passenger Consent Agreement: Department of Transportation regulations require that we inform you that your purchase is subject to supplemental price increases beyond our control that may be imposed after the date of purchase. Such increases may come about due to increased fees, fuel surcharges, government tax increases, fluctuations in foreign exchange markets or any combination of these events. Post-purchase price increases may be applied to your invoice due to these unforeseen cost increases from suppliers. While a post-purchase price increase is very rare and not anticipated, Burkhalter Tours will inform you of any increases as soon as possible.
