wildlife of Africa on your morning and afternoon open vehicle, guided, game viewing drives through the breathtaking scenery of the private reserve. (B,L,D)



lunch, you won't find a better combination of beach and wildlife than you do at Boulders Beach. Hundreds of Jackass Penguins waddle freely amongst the human 'visitors' on the white sand beach. Have your camera ready! (B,L)

Deposits and Payments: Please make checks payable to Burkhalter Tours. Most major credit cards are also accepted, although sometimes a cash discount may be offered. A deposit of **\$300 per person (\$649 w/Mayflower insurance)** is required to secure reservations. All tour confirmations are subject to receipt of signed tour application and payment verification. <u>Final payment is due on or before May 20, 2021.</u>

Cancellations/Refunds: All cancellations are subject to a \$50 Burkhalter Tours service fee that may not be covered by tour operator insurance. In addition to the service fee and possible airline penalties, tour cancellation penalties are as follows:

Cancel prior to May 20, 2021: Deposit is non-refundable

Cancel after May 20, 2021: Trip is non-refundable

No refund will apply on unused portions of the tour. If a roommate cancels, the remaining traveler may have to pay any single room supplement that is incurred. Name changes and departure date changes are considered reservation cancellations and are subject to cancellation fees. Once issued, airline tickets are 100% non-refundable.

Travel insurance is strongly recommended to protect your investment if you have to cancel the tour, and also, to provide coverage for emergency expenses during the tour. Coverage is available from Mayflower Tours for \$349 per person - their plan allows cancellation up to the day before departure "for any reason," meaning you will not have to file a claim no matter the reason for cancelling. Other plans may also be available - ask your agent for more information.

Tour Conditions: This tour is a regular Mayflower Tours departure and no minimum number of Burkhalter travelers is required for the tour to operate. Mayflower Tours generally offers airport transfer service from the Dutch Mill Park'n Ride in Madison (7 days free parking allowed in that lot). With at least 10 paid travelers, Mayflower Tours will pick up our group at the Burkhalter office on Mineral Point Road, meaning travelers will be able to leave their cars in the Burkhalter lot while they are traveling. With 15 paid travelers, a Burkhalter Tours host may travel with the group from Madison to provide additional service throughout the tour. All tour arrangements are based upon tariffs in effect on 3/10/2020 and are subject to change. Once deposit has been received, any changes to air or land arrangements may be assessed a \$50 revision fee. Revision fees may be higher once air is ticketed.

Air Transportation: The airfare portion of the tour price is subject to change until ticketed. Group airfares may require a minimum of 10 travelers. Airline schedules are subject to change by the airlines at any time. Group seat assignments are usually done by the airline, and changes are subject to availability, which may be limited. If specific seat assignments are vital to your enjoyment of the tour, we recommend individual air reservations rather than booking with the group.

Accommodations: The hotels and lodges on this tour are first-class properties with private ensuite facilities. Most rooms will be non-smoking rooms with two beds. Burkhalter Tours and Mayflower Tours can make special requests on your behalf, but we cannot guarantee that requests will be granted.
