

Tour Highlights: This laid back tour of Southern California explores popular getaways and more in the Golden State. Visit the 18th-century mission in San Juan Capistrano, tour the Rat Pack's mid-century modern homes in Palm Springs, and taste today's perfectly aged reds and whites in the picturesque wine regions of Temecula and Paso Robles. You'll also feel the wind in your hair on a Jeep tour through Joshua Tree National Park, the sand in your toes along San Diego's 70 miles of beaches, and your inner movie star emerge as you strut down Rodeo Drive.

Day 1, Mon., Nov. 1: Arrive in L.A./Beverly Hills. Welcome to L.A.! At 6 pm, meet your Tour Director and traveling companions for a welcome drink.

Day 5, Fri., Nov. 5: Coronado - Temecula - Palm Springs - Palm Desert. Relax this morning before exploring Temecula and wine tasting at a local vineyard. Travel to Palm Springs this afternoon for sightseeing with a local guide before arriving in Palm Desert. The evening is yours to enjoy on your own. (B)

Day 6, Sat., Nov. 6: Palm Desert - Excursion to Joshua Tree National Park. After breakfast, travel to Joshua Tree

Arrive at the Ranch in Death Valley National Park and choose to explore the visitor's center or go for a hike on your own before your included dinner. (B,D)



Terms and Conditions

I.D./Citizenship: Names must match the traveler's photo I.D. Complete I.D. name, gender and birth date are required to confirm reservations per TSA/airline requirements.

Deposits and Payments: Please make checks payable to Burkhalter Tours. Most major credit cards are also accepted, although sometimes a cash discount may be offered. A deposit of \$300 per person is required to secure reservations. All tour confirmations are subject to receipt of signed tour application and payment verification. **Final payment is due by August 13, 2021**.

Cancellations/Refunds: All cancellations are subject to a \$50 Burkhalter Tours service fee that may not be covered by tour operator insurance. In addition to the service fee and possible airline penalties, tour cancellation penalties are as follows:

Cancel prior to August 13, 2021: Deposit is non-refundable

Cancel after August 13, 2021: Tour is non-refundable

No refund will apply on unused portions of the tour. If a roommate cancels, the remaining traveler may have to pay any single room supplement that is incurred. Name changes and departure date changes are considered reservation cancellations and are subject to cancellation fees. Once issued, airline tickets are 100% non-refundable.

Travel insurance is strongly advised in order to protect your investment. Coverage for trip cancellation/interruption/delay, and medical emergency expenses is available from Globus for \$299, and we recommend purchase at the time of booking. Ask your agent for more information.

Tour Conditions: This tour is a regular Globus tour departure and no minimum number of Burkhalter travelers is required for the tour to operate. With 14 Burkhalter participants, a Burkhalter Tours host may travel with the group to provide leadership on flights and while traveling. All arrangements are based upon tariffs in effect on this date and are subject to change. Once deposit has been received, any changes to air or land arrangements may be assessed a \$50 revision fee. Revision fees may be higher once air is ticketed.

Air Transportation: The airfare portion of the tour price is an estimate and is based on a group air contract requiring a minimum of 10 travelers. Airline seat assignments can only be requested after final payment and may be limited in availability. If specific seat assignments are vital to your enjoyment of the tour, we recommend individual air reservations. Deviations from the group air schedule may result in a different airfare. Routing and schedules are subject to change.

Accommodations/Coach Transportation: Tour hotels are deluxe and moderate deluxe and include private ensuite facilities, typically with two beds. Touring coaches are deluxe vehicles with panoramic windows and seats that partially recline. Single travelers are allocated one seat only.

Traveler Fitness: Travelers should be in reasonably good health, able to climb stairs and walk moderate distances. Individuals with physical and/or cognitive limitations must be accompanied by an able individual who will assume complete responsibility for them -tour personnel cannot and will not provide such assistance.
