

Tour Itinerary: Enjoy the beautiful scenery and lovely towns along the Rhône and Saône Rivers. As you leisurely cruise through the wine country of France you will enjoy guided walks through vineyards and regional wine tastings while exploring the architectural heritage of Southern France.

Day 1, Fri., May 28: Depart Chicago. Depart the USA on your overnight flight to Lyon, France.

Day 2, Sat., May 29: Welcome to France! Welcome to Lyon, at the junction of the Rhône and Saône rivers. Upon arrival, you'll be met by a representative of Mayflower Cruises and Tours and transferred to the Emerald Liberté. Settle into your new surroundings and enjoy dinner onboard as the ship departs for Chalon-Sur-Saône this evening. (D)

Day 3, Sun., May 30: Chalon-Sur-Saône-Beaune. Chalon—Sur—Saône is best known as the birthplace of photography and the centre of Burgundy's wine region. Travel by road to the quaint village of Beaune, where you visit the Hospices de Beaune, one of the finest examples of French 15th—century architecture. Marvel at the multi—colored roofs of this former hospital, now a museum, which has become one of the symbols of Burgundy. (B,L,D)

Day 4, Mon., May 31: Lyon. Lyon, France's third largest city, is steeped in history and a former Roman capital positioned at the confluence of the Rhône and Saône Rivers. Today, take part in the guided tour of Lyon, which starts with a drive to the Basilique Notre Dame de Fourvière, Lyon's hilltop church, with stunning views over the town. Then pass by the recently rediscovered Roman amphitheater and walk through the cobbled streets of the old town with its including secret alleyways. (B,L, D)

Day 5, Tue., June 1: Tournon. Join your local guide for a walking tour of Tournon, dominated by the 16th-century castle and Roman ruins.

Sensations of Lyon- Page 2 H3135

Nestled in the valley near the steep slopes of le Massif Central, France's 3rd largest mountain range, it is picture-perfect. The area has a long tradition in wine making, including the renowned wine growing centre of Tain l'Hermitage across the river. (B,L,D)

Day 6, Wed., June 2: Viviers. Arrive in Viviers, a town which still has a lot of flare. Viviers is also the home of one of France's oldest cathedrals. Join an included city tour exploring all the architectural heritage of this quaint town. (B,L,D)

Day 7, Thu., June 3: Avignon. With a rich history from Celtic beginnings, Avignon is one of the few French cities to have preserved it ramparts, historic center and churches. Classified as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the city is well known for the imposing Palace of the Popes. Your guided walk takes you through this historic center, strolling the cobbled lanes, overlooking the famous 'Pont d'Avignon'. (B,L,D)


Day 8, Fri., June 4: Arles. The UNESCO World Heritage Site and Provençal town of Arles combines all of the region's charms. While strolling through the streets, medieval in character, with the local guide, you'll discover why the colorful houses were an inspiration to Vincent Van Gogh and other famous artists. But your land adventure is just beginning as you journey by coach to Nice on the famed Cote d'Azur. Day 12, Tue., June 8: Nice / USA. It's time to bid 'au revoir' to France and depart to the Nice airport for your flight home. (B)













TOUR TERMS AND CONDITIONS - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

I.D./Citizenship: Travelers must possess a passport that is valid for six months beyond the return date of the tour. Complete passport name, gender and birth date are required to confirm reservations per TSA/airline requirements.

Deposits and Payments: Please make checks payable to Burkhalter Tours. Most major credit cards are also accepted, although a cash discount may be offered. A deposit of \$450 per person (+ Mayflower insurance premium if you choose to buy that) is required to secure reservations. All tour confirmations are subject to receipt of signed tour application and payment verification. **Final payment is due by February 15, 2021.**

Cancellations/Refunds: All cancellations are subject to a \$50 Burkhalter Tours service fee that may not be covered by tour operator insurance. In addition to the service fee and possible airline penalties, tour cancellation penalties are as follows:

Cancel prior to February 15, 2021: Deposit is non-refundable Cancel after February 15, 2021: Trip is non-refundable

No refund will apply on unused portions of the tour. If a roommate cancels, the remaining traveler may have to pay any single room supplement that is incurred. Name changes and departure date changes are considered reservation cancellations and are subject to cancellation fees. Once issued, airline tickets are 100% non-refundable.

Travel insurance is strongly advised in order to protect your investment. Coverage for trip cancellation/interruption/delay, and medical emergency expenses is available from **Mayflower for \$469.** Other plans may also be available. Ask your agent for information.

Tour Conditions: This tour is a regular Mayflower Cruises and Tours departure and no minimum number of Burkhalter travelers is required for the tour to operate. With 20 paid travelers, a Burkhalter Tours host may accompany the group to provide additional service throughout the tour. All arrangements are based upon tariffs in effect on date of brochure production and are subject to change. Once deposit has been received, any changes to air or land arrangements may be assessed a \$50 revision fee. Revision fees may be higher once air is ticketed. Itineraries are subject to change.

Air Transportation: The airfare portion of the tour price is subject to change until ticketed. Group airfares may require a minimum of 10 travelers. Airline schedules and routing are subject to change by the airlines at any time. Group seat assignments are usually done by the airline, and changes are subject to availability, which may be limited.
