

**Tour Highlights:** Exotic and fascinating, the Kingdom of Morocco is rich in history and culture, offering intriguing historic sights, authentic cuisine, and changing scenery. Be enchanted by beautiful landscapes, stunned by the beauty of the desert, and surprised by the mountain scenery of the Middle Atlas.

**Day 1, Wed., Apr. 7: Depart Home.** Fly overnight from Chicago's O'Hare Airport to Africa.

**Day 2, Thu., Apr. 8: Arrive in Casablanca, Morocco.** Welcome to Morocco! After settling into your hotel, the rest of the day is free for you to explore this ancient land and get adjusted to the time.

**Day 3, Fri., Apr. 9: Casablanca.** Enjoy your day at leisure. Later, meet your Tour Director and fellow travelers. (B)

Day 4, Sat., Apr. 10: Casablanca—Rabat—Meknes—Fez. A short ride along the coast to Rabat, once a lair of the corsairs and now the country's capital. Sightseeing includes the Royal Palace, Hassan Tower, and the Kasbah of Oudayas. You'll be reminded of the time when Morocco was the Roman province of Mauretania as you visit the fine Roman Relics of Chellah and its gardens. Continue to Meknes. During your guided tour, see its monumental gates, mosque, palace, and miles of protective walls. Visit its Royal Stables, originally built to house 12,000 of the royal horses. Travel east towards Fez, Morocco's most enchanting city. (B,D)

Day 5, Sun., Apr. 11: Fez. Today you get to have leisure time in ancient Fez, with outstanding scenic beauty. Visit the exotic ancient Medina on the optional sightseeing tour, a maze of narrow, bustling streets and alleys that are home to colorful souks. (B) Day 6, Mon., Apr. 12: Fez—Ifrane—Erfoud. Travel today into the very heart of Morocco. Stop in the quiet, French-built alpine mountain resort of Ifrane. Verdant cedar forests give way to volcanic mountains and windswept plains as you travel across the Middle Atlas range, pass fortified mud-and-straw villages and descend into

the spectacular Ziz Gorges. The landscape becomes progressively more arid and you enter a stony desert. Approaching Erfoud, encounter an unexpected and breathtaking surprise: the peaceful oasis of the Ziz Valley. (B,D)

**Day 7, Tue., Apr. 13: Erfoud.** The best choice today is an included excursion to Rissani to see the Mausoleum of Moulay Ali Sharif, the first ruler of the Alaouite Dynasty. This evening, enjoy an optional excursion in the desert. (B,D)

Day 8, Wed., Apr. 14: Erfoud—Ouarzazate. Enjoy the drive through the eastern slopes of the Atlas Mountains and arrive at the Tinerhir oasis with its green valley of palms and local villages. On to the impressive Todra Gorge, then along the Dades Valley. Arrive in the film capital of Morocco, Ouarzazate, where you'll visit the Kasbah de Taourirt, the intricate and fascinating residence of Pasha Thami el Glaoui. (B,D)

Day 9, Thu., Apr. 15: Ouarzazate—Aït—Marrakesh. Travel to Aït Benhaddou, a kasbah famous as a film location for Lawrence of Arabia and Gladiator. Pass through picturesque villages surrounded by craggy mountains towards 7,414-foot-high Tizi-n-Tichka Pass in the heart of the High Atlas Mountains. Each new twist in the road leads to a different, more dramatic landscape. Leaving the pass behind, see the landscape gradually change to a tapestry of red ochre. Enter the gates of the red-colored imperial city of Marrakesh, justly considered the most fascinating of all Moroccan cities. An optional evening excursion is a fitting way to end the day. (B)

**Day 10, Fri., Apr. 16:** Marrakesh. The included city sightseeing with a local guide starts with an orientation drive followed by a walk through the ancient quarters to the fascinating Jemma-El-Fna square and its exotic bazaar, Bahia Pal-

ace, and Majorelle gardens. You'll feel as if you've stopped the march of time. (B,D)

Day 11, Sat., Apr. 17: Marrakesh—Casablanca. Leave Morocco's magical city of Marrakesh for the journey back to Casablanca. On arrival, see the main sights in the company of a local guide. (B)

**Day 12, Sun., Apr. 18: Casablanca.** Your vacation ends with breakfast this morning. (B)

## **TOUR TERMS AND CONDITIONS - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY**

*I.D./Citizenship*: Travelers must possess a passport that is valid for six months beyond the return date of the tour. Complete passport name, gender and birth date are required to confirm reservations per TSA/airline requirements. Non-U.S. passport holders are responsible for determining their own entry requirements.

**Deposits and Payments:** Please make checks payable to Burkhalter Tours. Most major credit cards are also accepted, although a cash discount may be offered. A deposit of \$300 per person is required to secure reservations. All tour confirmations are subject to receipt of signed tour application and payment verification. **Final payment is due by January 25, 2021.** 

**Cancellations/Refunds:** All cancellations are subject to a \$50 Burkhalter Tours service fee that may not be covered by tour operator insurance. In addition to the service fee and possible airline penalties, tour cancellation penalties are as follows:

Cancel prior to January 25, 2021: Deposit is non-refundable

Cancel after January 25, 2021: Trip is non-refundable

No refund will apply on unused portions of the tour. If a roommate cancels, the remaining traveler may have to pay any single room supplement that is incurred. Name changes and departure date changes are considered reservation cancellations and are subject to cancellation fees. Once issued, airline tickets are 100% non-refundable.

*Travel Insurance* is strongly advised in order to protect your investment. Coverage for trip cancellation/interruption/delay, and medical emergency expenses is available. Ask your agent for information.

**Tour Conditions**: This tour is a regular Cosmos departure and no minimum number of Burkhalter travelers is required for the tour to operate. Mary Kay Harmon, a Burkhalter Tours host will accompany the group to provide additional service throughout the tour. All arrangements are based upon tariffs in effect on date of brochure production and are subject to change. Once deposit has been received, any changes to air or land arrangements may be assessed a \$50 revision fee. Revision fees may be higher once air is ticketed. Itinerary is subject to change by the tour operator.
