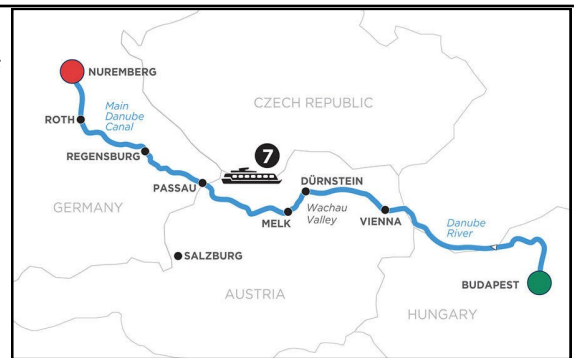
Day 5, Thursday, Oct. 28: Dürnstein, Wachau Valley, Melk. This morning we will visit Dürnstein, famous for the castle that imprisoned King Richard the Lionheart during the crusades. Next, enjoy the picturesque Wachau Valley on our way to Melk. Enjoy a coffee or a cocktail on the Sky Deck as you view the rolling hills and vineyards as we cruise along. You will have the chance this afternoon to visit Melk's most famous landmark, the 11th-century Benedictine Abbey, one of Europe's largest monasteries, with its amazing frescoed ceilings, statues, incredible library and ornate pipe organ. (B,L,D)

Day 6, Friday, Oct. 29: Passau. It is time to explore Germany as we cross the border this morning from Austria. Known as the "City of Three Rivers" because the Danube, Inn and Ilz Rivers all meet here, Passau is a charming town to explore. However, if you choose, you can pick from optional excursions to Cesky Krumlov, the "Pearl of the Bohemian Forest" or Salzburg, famous for its musical history (home to Mozart and where "The Sound of Music" was filmed). The hills really are alive with the sound of music! (B,L,D)

Day 7, Saturday, Oct. 30: Regensburg. The Bavarian city of Regensburg is known for its well-preserved medieval core due to being the only German city not bombed during WWII. You will fall in love with this town as you stroll through the narrow streets and alleys and experience the history of this town. And one more gem you can experience is Bavaria's oldest monastery, the 7th-century Weltenburg Abbey. Take an optional excursion to the Abbey and enjoy the stunning setting in the Danube Gorge, the splendid interior and the oldest monastic brewery in the world! (B,L,D)

Day 8, Sunday, Oct. 31: Roth, Excursion to Nuremberg. Our last port before departure is Roth. You can enjoy a guided sightseeing tour of the Bavarian town, with its half-timbered houses, market square and 1535 hunting lodge, Schloss Ratibor. If you enjoy medieval architecture, you could also do an excursion to Nuremberg. See the gilded fountain, Gothic cathedral and Kaiserburg Castle. Or if you want to spend your last day relaxing, how about enjoy an onboard lecture about the Main-Danube Canal, linking these two rivers to make a vital connection enabling navigation between the North and Black Seas. (B,L,D)

Day 9, Monday, Nov. 1: Nuremberg (Disembarkation) - Return to U.S. Sadly, your tour ends after breakfast this morning, when you transfer to the Nuremberg airport for your homeward-bound flight. (B)

TOUR TERMS AND CONDITIONS - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

I.D./Citizenship: Travelers must possess a passport valid for at least six months beyond the tour dates with names matching those on their tour and flight reservations. Complete name, gender and birth date are required to confirm reservations per TSA/airline requirements.



Deposits and Payments: Please make checks payable to Burkhalter Tours. Most major credit cards are also accepted. **A deposit of \$300 per person** is required to secure reservations. All tour confirmations are subject to receipt of signed tour application and payment verification. **Final payment is due before July 19, 2021.**

Cancellations/Refunds: All cancellations are subject to a \$50 Travel Headquarters service fee that may not be covered by tour operator insurance. In addition to the service fee and possible airline penalties, tour cancellation penalties are as follows:

Cancel prior to July 19, 2021: Deposit is non-refundable

Cancel after July 19, 2021: Trip is non-refundable

No refund will apply on unused portions of the tour. If a roommate cancels, the remaining traveler may have to pay any single room supplement that is incurred. Name changes and departure date changes are considered reservation cancellations and are subject to cancellation fees. Once issued, airline tickets are 100% non-refundable.

Travel insurance: We strongly recommend the purchase of travel insurance to protect your investment and also to give you medical coverage in case of an emergency during the trip. Avalon Waterways offers a protection plan \$259-\$299, but other plans are also available based on your needs. Most protection plans should be purchased at time of deposit. Ask your agent for more information.

Tour Conditions: This tour is a regular Avalon cruise departure. There are no minimum number of Burkhalter travelers required for the tour to operate. All arrangements are based upon tariffs in effect on 9/10/2020 and are subject to change. Once deposit has been received, any changes to air or land arrangements may be assessed a revision fee between \$50-\$250. Revision fees may be higher once air is ticketed.

Air Transportation: The airfare portion of the tour price is subject to change until ticketed. Group airfares may require a minimum of 10 travelers. Airline schedules and routing are subject to change by the airlines at any time. Group seat assignments are usually done by the airline, and changes are subject to availability, which may be limited. If specific seat assignments are vital to your enjoyment of the tour, we recommend individual air reservations rather than booking with the group. Airline seat assignments may only be requested after final payment and may be limited in availability.

Accommodations: Your river ship and tour hotels are first-class or better properties with private ensuite facilities. Hotels are subject to change.

Traveler Fitness: Travelers should be in reasonably good health, able to board a motorcoach in a timely manner, climb stairs and walk moderate distances over sometimes uneven ground. Individuals with physical and/or cognitive limitations must be accompanied by an able individual who will assume complete responsibility for them. Tour personnel and hosts cannot and will not provide this kind of assistance.

Passenger Consent Agreement: Department of Transportation regulations require that we inform you that your purchase is subject to supplemental price increases beyond our control that may be imposed after the date of purchase. Such increases may come about due to increased fees, fuel surcharges, government tax increases, fluctuations in foreign exchange markets or any combination of these events. Post-purchase price increases may be applied to your invoice due to these unforeseen cost increases from suppliers.
