Day 4, Monday, Apr. 11: Charleston. The next stop is Savannah, known for its beautiful coastal landscapes, well-preserved architecture and rich, vibrant history. Upon arrival, you will visit the American Prohibition Museum with costumed guides and a classic cocktail in the Speakeasy. Overnight at Embassy Suites by Hilton Historic Savannah or similar for 3 nights. (B)

Day 6, Wednesday, Apr. 13: Savannah. After breakfast, you will learn about Savannah on a trolley tour with a local guide. The rest of the day is free to enjoy Savannah! (B)

Day 7, Thursday, Apr. 14: Jekyll Island & St. Simons Island. There are many small islands on the South Carolina coast and you will experience two of them today. Start with a trolley tour of the Club Historic District on Jekyll Island followed by a farewell lunch at the historic Jekyll Island Club. Next, head to St. Simons Island for an orientation drive with free time to explore on your own. This evening, enjoy a final night in Savannah on your own. (B,L)
