On the cruise, your guide will help you look for freshwater turtles, caimans, herons, toucans, egrets and monkeys. Upon arrival at the lodge, enjoy some free time before a slideshow presentation about the park. Overnight at Evergreen Lodge or similar for 2 nights. (B,L,D)

Day 3, Monday, Feb. 7: Tortuguero National Park. You will have the opportunity to enjoy all the park has to offer with a guided boat cruise with a naturalist through remote areas of the park, followed by a rainforest walk. What a special way to learn about this amazing park. (B,L,D)

Day 4, Tuesday, Feb 8: Sarapiqui & Arenal. After a morning boat trip, you will have a guided tour of a local family-owned pineapple farm and learn about the history of the industry in Costa Rica. This afternoon you will enjoy free time at your resort. Overnight at Volcano Lodge & Gardens or similar for 2 nights. (B,L,D)

Day 5, Wednesday, Feb. 9: Arenal Volcano National Park. Costa Rica's famous Arenal Volcano awaits you today! Enjoy a guided visit of the park, including lava trails and nature that has recovered from past lava flows. Then a walking tour of La Fortuna de San Carlos offers spectacular views of the active Arenal Volcano. The day ends with a dip in the curative and relaxing pools at Tabacon Hot Springs before dinner at the hot springs. (B,D)

Day 6, Thursday, Feb. 10: Monteverde. A trip to Costa Rica would not be complete without a visit to the Sky Walk Hanging Bridges, which combines trails and suspension bridges through the canopy of Monteverde Cloud Forest.....sure to leave you in awe! Overnight at El Establo Mountain Lodge or similar for 2 nights. (B,L)

Day 7, Friday, Feb. 11: Monteverde. Get out the camera and binoculars today as you visit Santa Elena Cloud Forest Reserve. Try to spot over 600 species of butterflies, 400 species of birds, 100 species of reptiles and 120 species of mammals. Enjoy a visit to a family-owned Ecological Sanctuary, including a tour, cooking class and lunch. (B,L,D)

Day 8, Saturday, Feb. 12: Sarchi, Grecia & San Jose. On the drive back to San Jose, you will stop in Sarchi, a local village known for its artists and their famous hand-painted oxcarts. Next, stop in Grecia to see the metal church, imported from Belgium in 1897. You will have the evening

free to enjoy San Jose. Overnight at Cariari Hotel San Jose or similar for 1 night. (B)

Day 9, Sunday, Feb. 13: San Jose. After touring around this beautiful country, it will be hard to return home. Enjoy breakfast and then head back to the airport to return home. (B)
