Day 4, Friday, July 1: Melk & Salzburg. Today will be fun-filled as you enjoy a cruise down the Danube River in Melk. Next, stop in Mondsee to visit the church used for filming the wedding scene in The Sound of Music. You will end the day in Salzburg with a guided walking tour that includes Mirabell Gardens, the Great Festival Hall and Residenz Square, followed by dinner at St. Peter Stiftskeller restaurant, one of Europe's oldest restaurants. Overnight at Imlauer Hotel Pitter Salzburg or similar for 2 nights. (B,D)

Day 5, Saturday, July 2: Salzburg. There are so many choices as you get to explore Salzburg today! Just a few attractions are Hohensalzburg Fortress, Old

Town, Hellbrunn Palace, Augustiner Bräu Beer Garden, Sound of Music Tour, Christmas Museum and Mozart's Birthplace. As you can see, there is not a shortage of things to see in Salzburg. (B)

Day 6, Sunday, July 3: Innsbruck & St. Moritz. In the winter, it is a world famous ski resort town, but in the summer, Innsbruck turns green and has some of the most beautiful scenery around! Enjoy a guided walk through Old Town to the Golden Roof. After some free time to browse, it is off to Switzerland! Overnight at Laudinella or similar for 1 night. (B,D)

Day 7, Monday, July 4: Zermatt. Another spectacular day is in store as you board the Glacier Express to Zermatt. Over, around and through the Swiss Alps.....sit back, relax and enjoy the breathtaking scenery. Overnight at Pollux or similar for 2 nights. (B,L)

Day 8, Tuesday, July 5: Zermatt. Zermatt is most famous for the Matterhorn, but there is so much more. Today is free to explore on your own. Perhaps join an excursion to the Matterhorn Glacier by cable car. Or take a stroll through this car-free town and enjoy the scenery. (B,D)

Day 9, Wednesday, July 6: Berne. A trip to Europe wouldn't be complete without a visit to a castle. Visit Chillon Castle on Lake Geneva, dating back to the 10th century, and enjoy a wine tasting. Then it is off to Berne, the "City of Fountains." Overnight at Holiday Inn Berne Westside or similar for 1 night. (B) Day 10, Thursday, July 7: Interlaken & Lucerne. Begin the day with a guided walking tour of Berne that includes a stop at Bear Park (yes, there are bears there) and enjoy panoramic views of the city from the Rose Garden and the Old Town. A stop in Interlaken for lunch on the way to Lucerne finishes up the day. Overnight at Ameron Hotel Flora or similar for 2 nights. (B)

Day 11, Friday, July 8: Lucerne. There is no place better to spend your last day of vacation than in Lucerne, known for its stunning medieval architecture and location on the edge of Lake Lucerne amid snow capped mountains. A walking tour includes the Lion monument, the Old Town and the Chapel Bridge. This evening, enjoy a private boat cruise followed by a farewell dinner. (B,D)


