to Hilo on the "Big Island," you will experience Volcanoes National Park. Your guide will show you the Kilauea Crater, steam vents, lava tubes and the visitor's center. En route to Kona, you will stop to try some famous Hawaiian sweetbread at Punalu'u Bake Shop. Overnight at Sheraton Kona Resort or similar for 3 nights. (B,L)

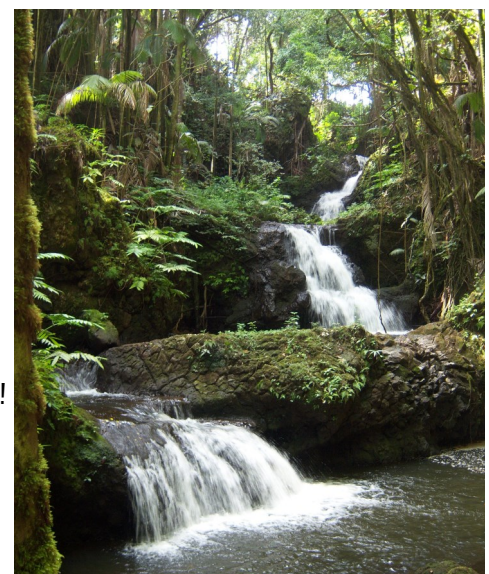

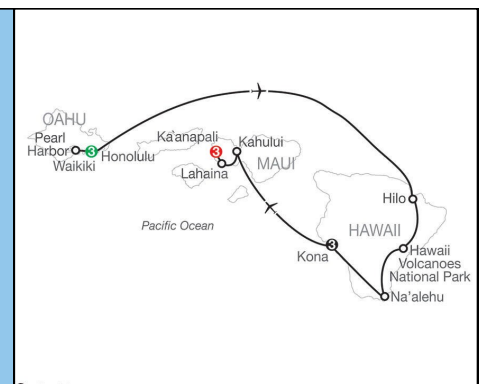
