

Balancing the great outdoors with the grand indoors, this Canadian Rockies vacation is the perfect marriage of peaks and pools, conifers and concierge, and sparkling lakes and spas.

Day 1, Monday, July 25: Calgary. Welcome to Canada! After getting settled, meet your Tour Director and traveling companions at 6pm for a welcome drink. Overnight at Westin Calgary or similar for 1 night.

Day 2, Tuesday, July 26: Calgary & Lake Louise. This morning, enjoy your Calgary orientation drive, perched in the foothills of the Canadian Rockies. Calgary is known as a home base for winter sports enthusiasts, but it is just as beautiful in the summer. Next, take a guided walk at Lake Louise and take in the turquoise water and soaring mountain backdrop. This afternoon and evening are free to enjoy the resort and surrounding area in Alberta's Banff National Park. Overnight at Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise or similar for 1 night. (B,D)

Day 3, Wednesday, July 27: Jasper. Rated as one of the top drives in the world by Condé Nast Traveller, the Icefield Parkway connecting Lake Louise with Jasper winds along the Continental Divide through soaring

rocky mountain peaks, icefields and vast sweeping valleys. You will stop at Peyto Lake, a vibrant blue glacier fed lake. Upon arrival at Jasper National Park, you will have free time to explore the area and the Fairmont. The resort is a village of heritage log cabins connected by picturesque paths, surrounded by incredible views and has all the comforts of home. Overnight at Fairmont Jasper Park Lodge or similar for 2 nights. (B,D)

Day 4, Thursday, July 28: Jasper & Maligne Lake. A beautiful way to start the morning with a Maligne Lake Cruise. Glide across the crystal waters, fed by glaciers of Jasper National Park. This afternoon, explore Jasper National Park on your own or join an optional excursion with a guided walk in Maligne Canyon. (B)

Day 5, Friday, July 29: Jasper, Columbia Icefield & Banff. Another amazing day is in store as you continue on the Icefields Parkway for the scenic drive to Columbia Icefield. You will explore the ancient Athabasca Glacier on a giant Ice Explorer and ride to a spot where you can walk on and feel the glacier. On the way to Banff, you will stop to see Natural Bridge, an impressive natural rock formation, over Kicking Horse River and Emerald Lake. Tonight enjoy some free time at the resort. Overnight at Fairmont Banff Springs Hotel or similar for 2 nights. (B)

Day 6, Saturday, July 30: Banff. Welcome to Banff National Park—Canada's first national park and the flagship of the nation's park system. Visitors come to hike, bike, ski, camp and just take in the breathtaking mountain scenery. No rigorous hiking today, but you will enjoy a scenic drive around Tunnel Mountain, featuring Bow River and Falls. This evening you will attend a presentation with a Canadian Mountie that includes history of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police and a photo opp. (B,D)

Day 7, Sunday, July 31: Calgary. We will head back to Calgary this morning for your return flight home after 2pm. With the incredible resorts and breathtaking scenery, our neighbors to the north have put on a show! (B)
