Day 6, Thursday, Oct. 13: Opatija & Zadar. It's on to the next country as we cross the border into Croatia, then relax and drink in the natural beauty of Opatija, a town nestled between the sparkling waters of the Adriatic and a lovely forest of bay laurels. Join your local guide in Zadar and learn about the historic Old Town with its exceptional cultural heritage, a treasury or archaeological and monumental riches of ancient and medieval times. Overnight at Hotel Porto or similar for 1 night. (B,D)

Day 7, Friday, Oct. 14: Krka, Trogir & Split. Get out the camera today as you visit Krka National Park, renowned for its breathtaking waterfalls and attractive water mills. Join your local guide to explore the outstanding natural beauty and home to more than 200 species of birds.....be sure to watch for osprey, golden eagles, peregrine falcons and Eurasian eagle-owls. Before ending in Split tonight, visit Trogir with its medieval walls, seaside promenade and maze-like marble streets. Overnight at Hotel Mondo or similar for 2 nights. (B)

Day 8, Saturday, Oct. 15: Split. This morning enjoy a guided tour of Split and learn how the ancient meets the modern. Split dates back to the 4th century when Emperor Diocletian built his phenomenal palace, now a UNESCO World Heritage site. (B,D)

Day 9, Sunday, Oct. 16: Ston & Dubrovnik. Enjoy views of the dramatic coastline as you make your way south to Dubrovnik. Along the way you will stop in Ston, renowned for its defensive walls...a major feat of medieval architecture. Overnight at Hotel Tirena or similar for 3 nights. (B,D)

Day 10, Monday, Oct. 17: Dubrovnik. Awaken this morning in the "Pearl of the Adriatic," one of the world's most stunning cities and discover Dubrovnik's many charms with your local guide. Game of Thrones fans should keep watch for filming sites used as King's Landing and Qarth! (B)







Day 11, Tuesday, Oct. 18: Kotor. An exciting journey awaits today as you set off to discover some of the highlights of Montenegro. Kotor, situated in a secluded part of the Gulf of Kotor, is the deepest natural fjord in the Mediterranean. Your local guide will introduce you to this UNESCO World Heritage Site, including a short boat crossing to visit Our Lady of the Rocks, one of two islets off the coast. (B)
