August 22-30, 2022

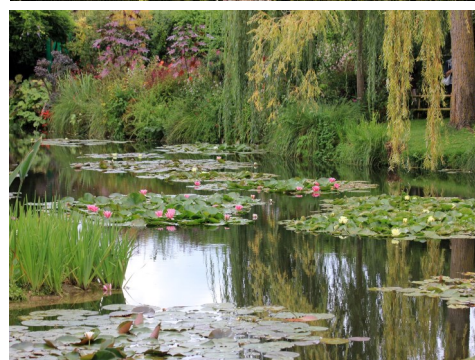
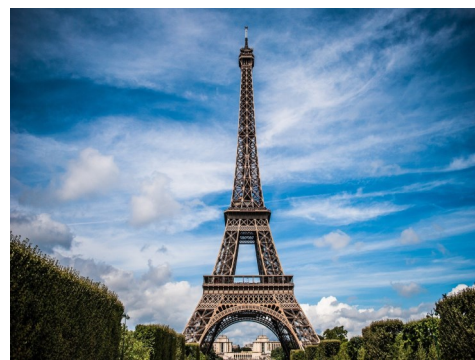

Day 4, Thu, Aug. 25: Caudebec. Another picture perfect day in France! Enjoy a relaxing bike ride along the river with your Adventure Host or take a guided trip along the Normandy Abbeys Route—where more than 100 medieval Benedictine and Augustine abbeys and churches were built along the Seine. (B,L,D)

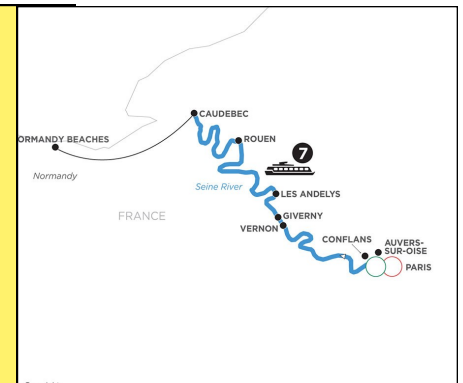
