Day 5, Friday, Oct. 28: Capri. Today, discover the breathtaking Island of Capri and the highest town on the island, Anacapri. Explore the local atmosphere and beautiful surroundings before cooling off by tasting some unique flavors at a gelato making demonstration. Then quench your thirst by sampling another regional favorite, Limoncello. (B,L)

Day 6, Saturday, Oct. 29: Amalfi Coast. Discover Amalfi's stunning coastline with miles of hairpin turns offering spectacular vistas. Enjoy free time in Amalfi for lunch or sightseeing...don't forget to make a stop at the Duomo, the town's greatest attraction. A pastry making lesson awaits you in the afternoon, before returning your hotel in Sorrento. (B)

**Day 7, Sunday, Oct 30: Paestrum.** Today's adventure explores the Greek Temple of Paestrum, an ancient Greek colony. This area is also famous for its

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production of Buffalo Mozzarella Cheese, which you'll get to sample after seeing exactly how it's made. The day concludes as you arrive into Cilento.(B)

Day 8, Monday, Oct 31: Agropoli. Discover one of the most vibrant cities along the Cilento coast, Agropoli. A cooking demonstration awaits you in the afternoon where you'll feast on your creation for lunch today. After lunch, you'll visit a local vineyard for a wine tasting event before returning to your hotel for a leisurely evening. (B,L)

Day 9, Tuesday, Nov. 1: Cilento area. Continue the immersion in local flavors with a visit to an olive mill and see first hand how the fruit is transformed into olive oil. You'll then enjoy an afternoon of leisure, before a dinner of traditional dishes is served. (B,D)

Day 10, Wednesday, Nov. 2: Rome. After breakfast, depart the Campania region and travel to Rome, where you'll make a stop at a local farm for an included lunch. (B,L)

Day 11, Thursday, Nov. 3: Rome. This morning, stroll through the Historic ruins of the Roman Forum, some dating back to the first kings of Rome. Visit the Coliseum, one of the greatest marvels in Roman architecture, and home to the battles of the gladiators. After diving deep into classic Roman history, enjoy your afternoon and evening on your own. Don't forget to sample some traditional Roman fare! (B)

Day 12, Friday, Nov. 4: Vatican City. Start with a guided tour to Vatican City, the spiritual center of the Roman Catholic Church. This tour also includes a walk through the Vatican Museums, which contain some of the most priceless (and famous) art treasures in the world. Marvel at the Sistine Chapel ceiling, painted impressively by Michelangelo. St. Peter's Basilica is full of magnificent artists from the Roman Renaissance and Baroque periods. After returning to Rome, the final afternoon is yours to explore independently before a farewell dinner this evening. (B,D)







Day 13, Saturday, Nov. 5: Depart for home. The journey comes to an end as you transfer to the airport for your return flight home.
