Day 3, Sunday, Dec. 4: Statue Of Liberty & One World. You'll start the morning with a ferry ride to visit the Statue of Liberty and Ellis Island. The Statue of Liberty has become a global symbol of freedom. Ellis Island was the first stop in the American journey for millions of immigrants from around the world. Later, visit the new One World Observatory, positioned on top of the tallest building in the Western Hemisphere, on levels 100, 101, and 102 of the 1,776 foot tall One World Trade Center building, One World Observatory provides unique, panoramic views of New York City, its most iconic sites, and surrounding waters. Then see the 9/11 Memorial and Museum, a tribute of remembrance to the victims and events of September 11, 2001. The 9/11 Memorial Museum is a moving experience located within the archaeological heart of the World Trade Center which documents the impact of the events and explores the continuing significance of September 11, 2001.
