

Glacier Discovery Cruise

August 19-27, 2023



Explore the scenic Inside Passage on this southbound Glacier Discovery Cruise with Holland America! This relaxing tour starts with one night in Anchorage before embarking on a 7 night cruise starting in Whittier and ending in Vancouver. Explore plenty of cruising as well as stops in Skagway, Juneau and Ketchikan.

Day 1, Saturday, Aug. 19: Depart for Anchorage. Upon arrival in Anchorage, transfer to your downtown hotel for a one-night stay and free time on your own.

Day 2, Sunday, Aug. 20: Anchorage & Whittier. You will have some time to explore Anchorage on your own this morning. Maybe take in some culture at one of the many museums or historical attractions. Grab a bike and enjoy a tour of Anchorage. Or stop and pick up some Alaska souvenirs. This afternoon, transfer to Whittier to board Holland America's *Nieuw Amsterdam*. The ship sails at 8:00pm.

Day 3, Monday, Aug. 21: Scenic Cruising. Sailing towards Hubbard Glacier feels like you're approaching another planet...it is that big and that otherworldly. Nicknamed "The Galloping Glacier", Hubbard has a rapidly advancing ice margin with up to seven feet in one day. Take in all the beautiful scenery as you enjoy the ship. You might attend a port talk with your on-board Alaska naturalist guide. Or, you might simply immerse yourself in the luxurious Holland America Line amenities. Be sure to watch for marine life—your captain will alert you if whales are nearby!

Day 4, Tuesday, Aug. 22: Glacier Bay. On your cruise to Glacier Bay, close your eyes and take in the sounds—the creaks and groans of "living" ice, the shrill cries of gulls and soaring eagles, the splash of a breaching humpback whale. Frosted peaks towering over mossy forests, wide tidewater glaciers (there are seven in the park), and marine wildlife are givens on Glacier Bay cruises, but every experience in this changing biosphere is unique.

Day 5, Wednesday, Aug. 23: Skagway. At the high of the Klondike Gold Rush, the port town of Skagway served as the primary gateway to the legendary gold

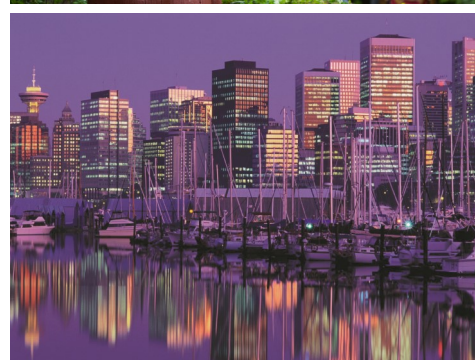
fields and quickly grew into Alaska's largest settlement. Immerse yourself in golf rush lore, including the Red Onion Saloon and the White Pass Railroad.

Day 6, Thursday, Aug. 24 5: Juneau. Juneau is the most remote, most beautiful and strangest state capital in the United States. Surrounded by water, forest and mountain sights, there is a lot to do in Juneau. Make sure to bring your binoculars as Juneau is the place to see wildlife. Keep a look out for wild deer, bald eagles and whales.

Day 7, Friday, Aug. 25: Ketchikan. Ketchikan has long been an important hub of the salmon-fishing and-packing industries—try your luck on a sportfishing excursion or simply savor the fresh seafood at one of the local restaurants. It is also one of the best spots along the Inside Passage to explore the rich cultural sights of Native Alaskan nations like the Tlingit, Haida and Tsimshian. You can see intricately carved totem poles at the Totem Heritage Center and Totem Bight State Park. The attractions of Saxman Village just outside of Ketchikan offer the chance to see Tlingit culture in action, with working carvers and a dance show in the clan house.

Day 8, Saturday, Aug. 26: Inside Passage Cruising. The Inside Passage is a protected network of waterways that wind through glacier-cut fjords and lush temperate rain forests. Stretching from Misty Fjords National Monument to famed Glacier Bay National Park, this is one of the greatest cruising routes in the world! Sailing the Inside Passage offer opportunities to spot some of Alaska's most iconic wildlife, with humpback whales and orca playing the bountiful waters alongside the ships, bald eagles soaring overhead and brown bears lumbering on the shoreline.

Day 9, Sunday, Aug. 27: Vancouver. Your vacation comes to an end as you transfer to the airport and fly home. Or if you are not quite ready, maybe extend your stay in Vancouver. Enjoy local attractions, fun-filled outdoor activities and an innovative culinary scene. Maybe check out the second-largest Chinatown in North America or relax at Stanley Park, larger than New York's Central Park. Ask your Burkhalter Travel Advisor about options!

TOUR TERMS AND CONDITIONS - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

I.D./Citizenship: Travelers must possess a passport book (not card) that is valid for at least six months beyond the tour's conclusion with names matching those on their tour and flight reservations. Complete name, gender and birth date are required to confirm reservations per TSA/airline requirements. It is recommended that any person charged with, or convicted of, a crime (including DUI) obtain the necessary approval before attempting to enter Canada. Non-U.S. citizens are responsible for confirming their own entry requirements.

Deposits and Payments: Please make checks payable to Burkhalter Travel. Most major credit cards are also accepted, although sometimes a cash discount may be offered. **A deposit of \$600 per person** is required to secure reservations. All tour confirmations are subject to receipt of signed tour application and payment verification. **Final payment is due by May 15, 2023.**

Cancellations/Refunds: All cancellations are subject to a \$50 Burkhalter Travel service fee that may not be covered by tour operator insurance. In addition to the service fee and possible airline penalties, tour cancellation penalties are as follows:

Cancel prior to May 15, 2023: Deposit is refundable

May 16—June 1, 2023: Deposit and airline fees are non-refundable

June 2—June 15, 2023: 50% non-refundable plus airline fees

June 16—July 16, 2023: 75% non-refundable plus airline fees

Cancel after July 16, 2023 : Trip is non-refundable

No refund will apply on unused portions of the tour. If a roommate cancels, the remaining traveler may have to pay any single room supplement that is incurred. Name changes and departure date changes are considered reservation cancellations and are subject to cancellation fees. Once issued, airline tickets are 100% non-refundable.

Tour Insurance: Travel insurance is strongly advised in order to protect your investment. Coverage for trip cancellation/interruption/delay, and medical emergency expenses is available from Burkhalter Travel, and we recommend purchase at the time of booking. Ask your agent for more information.

Tour Conditions: This tour is a regular Holland America tour departure and no minimum number of Burkhalter travelers is required to operate. With 20 Burkhalter participants, a Burkhalter Travel host may travel with the group to provide additional customer service while traveling. All arrangements are based upon tariffs in effect on January 1, 2022 and are subject to change. Once deposit has been received, any changes to air or land arrangements may be assessed a \$50 revision fee. Revision fees may be higher once air is ticketed.

Air Transportation: Group air requires a minimum of 10 travelers. Airline seat assignments can only be requested after final payment and may be limited in availability. If specific seat assignments are vital to your enjoyment of the tour, we recommend individual air reservations prior to final payment. Deviations may result in a different airfare. Routing and schedules are subject to change.

Accommodations/Coach Transportation: Generally, first class Westmark hotels are used throughout and include private ensuite facilities, typically with two beds. Touring coaches are deluxe vehicles with panoramic windows and seats that partially recline. Single travelers are allocated one seat only.

Traveler Fitness: Travelers should be in reasonably good health, able to board a motorcoach in a timely manner, climb stairs and walk moderate distances. Individuals with physical and/or cognitive limitations must be accompanied by an able individual who will assume complete responsibility for them - tour personnel cannot and will not provide such assistance.

Passenger Consent Agreement: Department of Transportation regulations require that we inform you that your purchase is subject to supplemental price increases beyond our control that may be imposed after the date of purchase. Such increases may come about due to increased fees, fuel surcharges, government tax increases, fluctuations in foreign exchange markets or any combination of these events. Post-purchase price increases may be applied to your invoice due to these unforeseen cost increases from suppliers. While a post-purchase price increase is very rare and not anticipated, Burkhalter Tours will inform you of any increases as soon as possible. By signing the tour application and making your deposit, you are acknowledging that you have been made aware and accept the fact that such increases may occur, and that you agree to pay Burkhalter Tours and our contracted suppliers accordingly.

Responsibility: Burkhalter Travel Agency, Inc., Holland America Line, their sales agents and tour personnel and any IATAN and connecting ARC carriers act only in capacity of agent for the passenger in all matters pertaining to hotel accommodations, sightseeing tours and any means of transportation and, as such, hold themselves free of responsibility for any damages from any causes whatsoever, including any loss, accident, delay or irregularity which may be occasioned by reason of defect in any vehicle or for the conduct of such other parties. Burkhalter Travel Agency, Inc. will not be responsible for any damage, expense or inconvenience caused by late transportation arrivals or departures, or by any change of schedule or other conditions; nor will they be responsible for the loss of, or damage to, baggage or any article belonging to the passenger.
