Day 5, Friday, Aug. 11: Dawson City. This morning, board a short flight bound for Dawson City. Your time here allows you to soak up the gold rush atmosphere as you stroll the town's dirt roads and wooden boardwalks. This afternoon you are free to choose optional excursions or explore on your own. Day 6, Saturday, Aug. 12: Dawson City. rustic log cabin. This afternoon, board the *Klondike Spirit* for your included sailing down the Yukon River on this nostalgic paddle-wheeler cruise. **Day 7, Sunday, Aug. 13: Whitehorse.** Travel by motorcoach along the route of Klondike gold stampeders to Whitehorse, capital of the Yukon Territory, with an included lunch stop along the Klondike Highway.

Day 8, Monday, Aug. 14: Skagway. After views of spectacular Lake Bennett, the White Pass and Yukon Route Railroad will provide a ride you'll always remember. From Fraser, the train will chug down the Gold Rush Trail of '98, through Tunnel Mountain and over the yawning chasm of Glacier Gorge to Skagway. Enjoy an overnight stay in the fabled gateway to the Klondike. Day 9, Tuesday, Aug. 15: Skagway. You'll have plenty of free time to explore the false fronted buildings, go for a hike, take a walking tour or perhaps dine at the famous Red Onion Saloon. Explore on your own or take optional excursions with an entire free day in Skagway. Don't miss the chance to visit Klondike Gold Rush National Historical Park and immerse yourself in colorful history. Tonight you will board your Holland America ship, Koningsdam, for the next part of your adventure.

Day 10, Wednesday, Aug. 16: Glacier Bay National Park. Spend your day cruising in this glorious national park as you listen to a Park Service Ranger narrate. Glacier Bay has more actively calving glaciers than anywhere else in the world...when a chunk of ice splits off a glacier, the sound is like thunder! Numerous on-ship activities will also draw your interest including Alaska lectures, computer classes, dance lessons, culinary demonstrations, wine tasting, entertaining evening shows and more!

Day 11, Thursday, Aug. 17: Ketchikan. Built over the water and climbing weathered stairways, Ketchikan clings to the shores of Tongass Narrows and drapes the mountains with a cheerful air. Noted for its sport fishing, it is equally-renowned for its ancient and contemporary native culture and for glorious Misty Fjords National Monument. For local color, explore Creek Street, visit the wonderful Totem Heritage Center or Tlingit Saxman Village. Day 12, Friday, Aug. 18: Inside Passage Cruising. Enjoy a day of scenic







cruising. An on-board naturalist will help you spot eagles, whales and other wildlife, easily viewed from the Promenade Deck or lounges with panoramic windows.

Day 13, Saturday, Aug. 19: Vancouver. Disembark your ship this morning and transfer to the airport for your homeward-bound flight departing this afternoon. Or ask your Burkhalter Travel Advisor about extending your stay in the beautiful city of Vancouver!
