



Rocky Mountaineer

First Passage to the West

August 6 - 13, 2023

Since 1990, Rocky Mountaineer has been taking guests through majestic landscapes on luxury trains. Travel through stunning scenery with highlights best seen from expansive glass-dome coaches. Enjoy vibrant storytelling, regionally-inspired cuisine and exceptional service onboard the train. All aboard!

Day 1, Sunday, August 6: Vancouver. Welcome to Vancouver! After flying from your home town to Vancouver, you will have the evening free to explore this bustling coastal city. Overnight stay for 2 nights in downtown Vancouver at Sheraton Wall Centre.

Day 2, Monday, August 7: Vancouver Sightseeing. Enjoy a sightseeing tour of Vancouver's spectacular North Shore with breathtaking views of the city, ocean and surrounding mountains. Highlights include the Capilano Suspension Bridge and the Grouse Mountain Skyride. Take a walk across the 137 metres (450 feet) long and 70 metres (230 feet) high bridge perched above the Capilano Canyon. Next stroll along Treetops Adventure on seven suspension bridges strung high in the evergreens for a squirrel's eye view of a thriving coastal rainforest. Take a gondola to the apex of Grouse Mountain, climbing to 4,100 feet above sea level. At the summit, take in the incredible views of Vancouver and the Pacific Ocean.

Day 3, Tuesday, August 8: Vancouver to Kamloops. Today, you board the Rocky Mountaineer in GoldLeaf Class and begin the journey eastward. See dramatic changes in scenery, from the lush green fields of the Fraser Valley, through forests and winding river canyons surrounded by the peaks of the Coast and Cascade Mountains, to the desert-like environment of the BC Interior. Highlights include the rushing waters of Hell's Gate in Fraser Canyon and the steep slopes and rock sheds along the Thompson River. Overnight at a hotel in Kamloops.

Day 4, Wednesday, August 9: Kamloops to Banff. Board the Rocky Mountaineer train at the Kamloops Station to continue your journey east to the

mighty Canadian Rockies and the province of Alberta. Travel across ranchlands, along rocky lakeshores, over high mountain passes and through the remarkable tunnels that form part of the rich rail history of the Canadian Rockies. Highlights include Craigellachie, where the last spike of the Canadian Pacific Railway was driven, the climb over Rogers Pass, Kicking Horse Canyon, the Spiral Tunnels and, of course, the iconic glaciers and snow-capped peaks of the Canadian Rockies. Overnight stay for 3 nights at Banff Caribou Lodge and Spa.

Day 5, Thursday, August 10: Banff Free Day. Enjoy a free day in Banff to explore as you wish. Banff has activities for all! Relax in the Banff hot springs, explore the charming town, or go for a wildlife adventure.

Day 6, Friday, August 11: Banff Sightseeing. Depart by motorcoach for your full -day tour of Banff and Yoho National Park. Yoho National Park offers magnificent natural wonders like the Spiral Tunnels, the turquoise serene waters of Emerald Lake and a natural Rock Bridge spanning the Kicking Horse River. We stop at The Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise with free time for you to revel in the breathtaking surroundings of Lake Louise. Return to Banff via motorcoach.

Day 7, Saturday, August 12: Banff to Calgary. Depart by private motorcoach for your full day sightseeing tour on your way to Calgary. Ride on the Banff Gondola - a spectacular eight-minute gondola ride to the top of Sulphur Mountain for 360-degree views of the Banff townsite and its surrounding mountains. Travel back in time at Canada's largest living history museum, Heritage Park Historical Village. This 127-acre attraction is home to the year-round Gasoline Alley Museum and is nestled on the banks of the Glenmore Reservoir with the picturesque backdrop of the Rocky Mountains. Meet friendly townsfolk in full period costume as you stroll down the wooden boardwalks or pop into any number of working shops, businesses or homes. Overnight stay for 1 night at Delta Calgary Downtown.

Day 8, Sunday August 13: Depart for Home. Your journey ends today after breakfast. Transfer to the airport and return flight home.

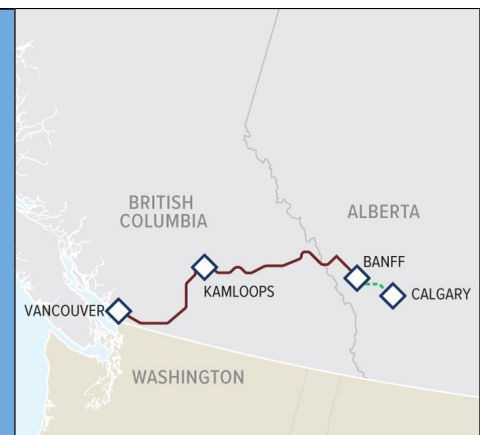
