

Sun-drenched beaches of the Algarve, exclusive golf resorts, medieval hilltop towns, colorful fishing villages, a cosmopolitan capital, the vine-filled valley of the Douro, wild remote mountains—Portugal has it all. But Europe's oldest country, which has had its eyes melancholically set on the sea and on a lost and glorious past, has turned its head toward Europe and is undergoing a profound modernization. Still, things move a bit slower in Portugal, "devagar" as residents say, and most tourists seem to like the pace.

Overnight in Tomar at Dos Templarios or similar for 1 night. (B,D) Day 5, Tues., May 9: Tomar - Coimbra - Porto. Today is a day for culture and tradition as you make your way to Porto! You'll start your day with breakfast before a visit the Convent of Christ in Tomar. You'll then make your way to Coimbra where you'll visit the University of Coimbra—the oldest in Portugal and one of the oldest in the world! Afterwards, you can sit back and relax on your motorcoach on a scenic drive to the second largest city in Portugal, Porto. Overnight in Porto at NH Collection Porto Batalha or similar for 2 nights. (B) Day 6, Wed., May 10: Porto. After breakfast you are heading out on a guided sightseeing tour of Porto which includes a drive to the mouth of the Douro

River—the highest-flow river of the Iberian Peninsula. Afterwards, you'll be able to taste internationally recognized Porto wines at Sandeman Wine Cellars. Day 7, Thurs., May 11: Guimaraes - Penafiel - Viseu. Today you leave Porto and head to Guimaraes where you'll go on an orientation walk of this medieval district. Day 9, Sat., May 13: Evora - Algarve. After lunch, you'll head to the coastal city of Algarve where you'll have the rest of the day to explore on your own! Overnight at Tivoli Lagos or similar for 2 nights. (B) Day 10, Sun., May 14: Algarve. Today you'll have the opportunity to take in the breathtaking views of the southern coastline of Portugal in Algarve. 
